

## GENERAL RULES FOR THE 2017-2018 STATE CLUB OF THE YEAR CONTEST

The contest among clubs in each District will start July 1, 2017 and ends June 30, 2018. Activities for which the club may have earned points for April, May, June will be consolidated with the July worksheet. Other months will be reported by completing a separate Cub Contest Worksheet or by utilizing the LCI online activity report for each month. All worksheets, if worksheets are used, must be received by the District Contest and Awards Chairman by the 5<sup>th</sup> of the following month. The Contest and Awards Chairman shall tabulate the points scored by each club and maintain cumulative totals. All information used to earn points in the contest will be shown on the Club Contest Worksheet. **No** corrections to previous worksheets shall be accepted. Tabulations showing current cumulative totals may be published in the District Newsletter from time to time.

The **JUNE 2017** Club Contest worksheet or LCI activity report **MUST BE RECEIVED** by the District Contest and Awards Chairman **NO LATER THAT JULY 5, 2017** to be considered in the contest. **Winners will be announced at the next state function.** The Contest and Awards Chairman in each District shall notify the Multiple District Contest and Awards Chairman as to the name of the winning club in each District and the cumulative point total for each winner.

A club which earns a cumulative total of **20,000 points** and which meets **ALL** the Eligibility Rules for the contest period shall be recognized as a Superior Club. Suitable awards or recognition shall be made by the District at an appropriate District meeting following the close of the contest period.
